We are grateful to the Friendship Baptist Church for allowing us to continue operations while we recovered from the financial setbacks of years past, but our membership asked for a place to call our own, and we listened. The steering committee found this location, less than a mile from the original Rebos and presented the possibility of purchase to the Board of Directors.

The board of directors moved quickly to determine the affordability and feasibility of buying the building. Having analyzed the results of several inspections which included the foundation, wiring and air conditioning systems, Michelle Buxton our Vice Chairman, who also happens to be a realtor, was able to get the already rock bottom price reduced even more.

After an informational membership meeting at which a straw vote demonstrated the membership's determination to purchase a place to call our own, and their support of this purchase, we moved ahead with scheduling a membership vote and a closing date contingent on the outcome. We closed last month and are moving forward.
